For your convenience, here is a full list of items that are accepted and not accepted as part of our program.

## Donated items we ACCEPT:

- Wheelchairs (non-electric)adult, bariatric (larger size) and children's
- Transport chairs
- Rollators
- Upright rollators, also known as upright walkers (rollators that allow a person to putheir forearms in cushioned cuffs and stand upright)
- Walkers (standard-typally with 2 wheels in front and 2 gliders in back)
- Knee scooters
- Canes (standard, folding, quad with 4 feet, tripod with 3 feet, some with swiveling/pivot
- base)
  Grabbers/reachers
- Crutches
- Bed rails (all styles and sizes)
- Tollet risers/bedside commodes (all styles and sizes)

## Donated items we DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Any POWER or ELECTRIC wheelchairs or scooters
- Wheelchairs, designed to meet a specific person's mobility needs
- Hospital beds
- Mattresses. new or used
- Cushions of any kind for wheelchairs
- Hoyer lift devices or similar hydraulic lift devices, manual or electric
- Stair rail systems
- Incontinence care items (adult diapers, bed pads, catheters, dlabetes supplies, etc.)
- Stabllizer boots ("moon boots")
- Cold therapy machines (cryotherapy devices to help control pain and swelling)
- CPAP machines
- Pillows (e.g., wedge)
